

Contest "Maritime University of Szczecin - setting a course for sustainable development"

Contest is aimed to:

- Undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students of the Maritime University of Szczecin
- all employees of the Maritime Academy of Szczecin

This event is organised under Rector and Vice-Rector for Innovation and Development patronage.

Scope of the competition:

The aim of the contest is to develop concepts, solutions for sustainable development (SDGs - Sustainable Development Goals), which can be implemented in Maritime University of Szczecin or in socioeconomic environment.

We improve ourselves, we improve AMS – proposing actions for sustainable development for a common future.

The task of the participant of the competition is to propose an idea that fits into the selected/selected sustainable development goals, such as: Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all (SDG 7); Build resilient infrastructure, promote inclusive and sustainable industrialization and foster innovation (SDG 9); Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable (SDG 11); Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts (SDG 13); Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development (SDG 14); or any other of the following 17 Sustainable Development Goals.

The form of the Competition work is arbitrary (description, presentation or other). Proposals should address actions falling within at least one of the three dimensions of sustainable development: economic, social or environmental. The vision may concern solutions consistent with the scope of AMS activity, but it may also be related to the functioning of the city of Szczecin and the region.

For example, it can propose solutions for safe and clean urban transport, innovative use of biofuels, or indicate good infrastructure patterns.

Awards:

Three winners of the competition will be selected, from which the winner will present his work to the University authorities.

There are three prizes in each group of participants, i.e., the group of undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students and the group of employees of the Maritime University of Szczecin.

- 1. The prizes in the group of undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students are as follows:
- a) 1st prize PLN 1,500 plus a weekend stay at the seaside at the Maritime University of Szczecin Retreat (*Dom Pracy Twórczej AMS*) in Świnoujście;
- b) 2nd prize PLN 1,000 plus a voyage onboard the MS Nawigator XXI;
- c) 3rd prize PLN 500.
- 2. The prizes in the group of employees of the Maritime University of Szczecin are as follows:
- a) 1st prize PLN 1,500 plus a weekend stay at the seaside in the Maritime University of Szczecin Retreat (*Dom Pracy Twórczej AMS*) in Świnoujście;
- b) 2nd prize PLN 1,000 plus a voyage onboard the MS Nawigator XXI;
- c) 3rd prize PLN 500.

The Winner of the 1st prize shall receive a voucher for 2 persons for a weekend stay at the Maritime University of Szczecin Retreat (to be redeemed on a date at his/her convenience). The Winner of the 2nd prize shall receive a voucher for a voyage onboard the MS Nawigator XXI (to be redeemed on a date at his/her convenience).

Baltic Trade and Invest So. z o.o. shall finance the cash prizes referred to in section 3(1) and (2) for all Winners of the Competition.
