1.	The trainee, regardless of their position, will be able to undertake the mandatory training required for the Electro-technical Officer Certificate on ships powered by main propulsion machinery power of 750 kW and more, in accordance with Section A-III/1 and the guidelines of Section B-III/1 of the STCW Code, as well as the requirements of Section A-VIII/2 and B-VIII/2 of the STCW Code regarding watchkeeping duties.
2.	On board the ship, conditions will be provided to enable the trainee to participate in an approved practical training programme, covering the tasks specified in the Training Record Book. The trainee will be given the opportunity to perform the tasks associated with the seagoing practice and will be supervised and assessed by a qualified officer.
3.	Training or assessment by officers will not be conducted during service duties if it could negatively
