# INFORMATION About the processing of your personal data

Pursuant to Article 13 and Article 26 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC hereinafter referred to as "RODO", we inform you that:

# I. Joint Controller of personal data

# III. Objectives and basis for processing

The purpose of processing is to organize and conduct the XXV National Olympiad of English of Higher Technical Universities.

## IV. Recipients of the data

Your personal data may be made available to authorized employees of the Joint Administrators and other authorities authorized to carry out inspections.

In case of necessity, your personal data may also be made available only to entities authorized to receive your data under applicable laws.

#### V. Transfer of data to third countries

We do not transfer your data outside the European Economic Area.

### VI. Data storage period

Your data obtained for the purpose of the XXV All-Poland English Language Olympiad of Technical Universities will be stored for the period of time necessary for the realization of the purpose referred to in pt. III of this Information and the statute of limitations for claims. Thereafter, as far as archival materials are concerned, storage will be in accordance with the Clerical Instruction developed at each of the Joint Administrators individually on the basis of the provisions of the Law of July 14, 1983 on National Archival Resources and Archives.

If you revoke your consent, the documents provided on the basis of your consent will be anonymized if one of the prerequisites specified in Article, 17 RODO is met, among others, the data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected.

### VII. Your rights:

You are entitled to:

- a) The right to access your personal data to obtain from the Administrator confirmation as to whether your personal data is being processed, and if it is, to obtain access to it and to provide you with information to the extent indicated in Article 15 of the RODO;
- b) the right to withdraw consent to the processing of your personal data. The right to withdraw consent at any time does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal;

## X. In connection with the processing of your personal data, we also inform you that:

- a) The Coordinating Co-Administrator and the Co-Administrator declare that they process your personal data in accordance with the principles relating to the processing of personal data set forth in Article 5 of the RODO;
- b) The Coordinating Co-Administrator shall keep all documentation relating to the joint administration, for the purpose of meeting the accountability requirement;
